

## Guidelines for Working in Groups

The assignments for the ODE course are designed to be done in groups of about six students. On each problem sheet there will be between three and five problems. You should look at all problems and discuss them with other group members. There are two kinds of problems: short and long. For the long problems each group only needs to hand in one solution. For the short problems each student should hand in individual written solutions. You won't need to write up all the solutions (the number required is on each sheet) but each group should make sure that at least one member solves each of the short problems. When you are done you should have a complete set of solutions for each sheet!

- The purpose of group work is for group members to help and teach each other: several heads are better than one!
- The group leader should ensure that the group meets regularly and that all members participate in discussions and contribute to writing up the solutions.
- The group leader should ensure that at least one member writes up a solution for each of the short problems, and that all solutions are handed in by the deadline.
- Come and see your tutor or myself if you are stuck. I am in room 105.
- The group solutions to the long problems should be written in Latex.
- Include any python code you have used in your work.
